



PROGRAM QUALIFICATION CHECKLIST

Clients must be low income by Alberta Low Income Guidelines to qualify

“Client” refers to the individual. The term “Client” may be used interchangeably with “Pet Owner. “PFP” refers to Parachutes for Pets, the organization providing services outlines in these Terms and Conditions

YOUR PET

PFP will only support a maximum of 2 pets per household

- Pet(s) owned by client for minimum of 12 months
- Pet(s) must be spayed or neutered or allow PFP to spay and neuter
- Pet(s) must be up to date on vaccinations or allow PFP to arrange
- Pet(s) must be registered with the City of Calgary at the end of the one year term

Proof of pet qualifications, photos of pets, and all supporting documents are required for program approval

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Pet owners must take any pet education classes at PFP recommended by the PFP Social Worker
- Attend scheduled consultations with the Social Worker
- Attend scheduled vet appointment's
- Pet owners are responsible for requesting and arranging for pick up of the food they need throughout the year, we will not automatically have a food hamper for them every 2 months.
- No additional pets may be acquired while in our programming
- Clients can withdraw from the program throughout the year if they find themselves in better financial situation
- Clients are required to inform PFP of any financial or pet related changes

PROGRAM TERMINATION:

- Clients caught selling any food/supplies provided by PFP will be banned from future assistance.
- Failure to comply with the above conditions may equal discharge from the program
- 12 months from the program start date the client will be discharged from the program
