She believes without Charlie's companionship, her journey would have been more challenging. Inspired by her own experience, Melissa is dedicated to offering resources to pet guardians facing financial obstacles to prevent unnecessary surrenders or euthanasia.

Parachutes for Pets was founded that day and 5 years later has helped thousands of pets and guardians stay together. Melissa's dedication to ensuring the safety and happiness of animals is truly inspiring. In September 2022, Melissa opened the first Pet Advocacy Center in Calgary, Alberta. This model offers comprehensive support to both pets and their guardians, with the added benefit of on-site social workers to ensure their well being.
